

# PROJECT SPECIFICATION

**Title :-** *Teaching and Learning Technology: the Student Viewpoint*

**Introduction:-**

WBS is continually reviewing possibilities for exploiting technology for teaching and administrative services to support student learning. It's Technology in Teaching and Learning Group (TTLG) sponsors projects, seminars and discussions.

**Problem / Objectives:-**

TTLG would like to gain a view of what technologies students would value, what purposes / objectives they would support, and how they might work efficiently and effectively. This would include an understanding of general theory of what drives technology acceptance, and of successful or failed experiments that are recorded in the literature, in the UK or overseas.

The TTLG would like an interim presentation near the beginning of term 2, with follow-up questions addressed during term 2.

In parallel, TTLG is sponsoring specific developments on the Law and Business Degree. You should monitor and evaluate these trials as part of your evidence base.

**Tasks:-**

- Research the literature and practice of technology in teaching and learning.
- Investigate a number of prescribed technologies (?) to understand their potential role.
- Survey a suitable set of students in order to gauge opinions, attitudes, actual use of technologies and possession or intent to acquire suitable technologies. Extend this to one or more focus group discussions. This needs to be done in term 1. Students may be from a cross-section of courses and years, possibly complemented by a specific target group.
- Develop a presentation for TTLG, highlighting issues. Follow up the results of the discussion with staff and students to form a final report.
